Retiring Board Member Nancy Hardy Smith '50



In the fall of 1999, the Alumni Association needed to fill the position of Board Secretary. A friend told the Association Vice President, **Donna Spring Falter '49 Jan.**, that **Nancy Hardy Smith '50** might be open to taking the position. Although no one on the Board knew Nancy, Donna called her. After telling her what the position would involve, at the end of their conversation Donna asked Nancy to take the position. Nancy had been working for the Columbus Law Firm of Kemp, Schaeffer & Rowe Co. L.P.A. for several years, but she was now working just part-time along with occasionally helping out at a smaller westside law firm. Nancy felt she had time to do the secretary position and accepted Donna's invitation. That started 23 years of Nancy volunteering with the Alumni Association.

The alumni activity that Nancy had most attended prior to becoming secretary was the Florida Mid-Winter Reunion. Nancy's sister, **Sue Hardy Garman '52**, lives in Orlando. It was always a convenient time for Nancy to go to Florida to visit Sue and they attended the Florida Reunion together. Nancy and Sue's father was **John Hardy, Jr. '24**. At the 2000 Florida Reunion, Nancy donated her father's 1924 yearbook to the Alumni Association. At that time, the Association was just starting to build a Yearbook Library, and John Hardy's (cardboard covered edition) yearbook was one of the first!

In 2001 when Donna Falter was elected to the position of Association President, she asked Nancy to be the Vice President. The following year, in 2002, Nancy succeeded Donna as Association President. Nancy may have only served two years as president, but the Association was in the midst of planning the 75th West High School Anniversary for 2004. It was the consensus of the group that for the continuity of planning that event the officers should remain for one more year. Nancy was very involved in the 75th Anniversary and helped to make it the largest and most successful event the Alumni Association has held.

From the beginning of her involvement with the Alumni Association, Nancy stepped up to volunteer every time anything was needed. She helped organize the summer All-Class Picnic.

For several years she ordered and maintained our supply of logo items we sold, which included bringing the boxes of things to all Association events. This included attending the all-day Hilltop Bean Dinner. When we started attending class reunions, Nancy was right there volunteering to go to the reunions and bring the logo items. She took our collection of logo items to the Florida Reunions several years and even took them to the West Coast Reunion, in Las Vegas, one year!


In 2013, when the West Athletic Director asked to meet with the Alumni Association about taking over the football concessions from the West Athletic Booster organization, Nancy was right there in the mix. After the meeting, when the Board discussed what it would take to run the concessions, Nancy was the first to say she would help! With Nancy's help, they also decided to run concessions during the girls' basketball games and the wrestling meets, something the Booster group had not done due to lack of help. Nancy continued to volunteer at the concessions until this past fall. She did offer to help then, but current Concessions Chair **Eli Bowen '74** assured her he had enough volunteers for the games. Plus, it was finally time for some younger alumni to step up and continue the tradition!

When Nancy notified Association President **Dave Dobos '73** she had decided to not run for a board position in 2022, he thanked her for her extensive service to the Alumni Association in the many positions she has held. The Alumni Association is a better organization because of Nancy and her leadership and volunteerism.

Dave Dobos history with the Alumni Association goes back to when the group was started in 1992. He was our first Treasurer. While he has maintained his membership with the group, his work, family, and other commitments resulted in Dave not being actively involved in several years. That was until 2015 when Paul Pennell '57 asked Dave if he would be interested in getting involved again and would he take the position of 2016 Vice President. Dave decided the time was right, and he agreed to become involved again. His intent was to be Vice President for one year then run for President in 2017. However, other projects he engaged in resulted in Dave asking to delay moving to President until 2018, which he did.

In addition to being actively involved in several outside groups, including the Hilltop Historical Society, Dave runs his own company, Next Level Prep. Among other things, NLP is involved in training high school student's various techniques on improving their ACT college test scores.

Dave didn't plan to be the Alumni Association President for four years. In addition to the many projects the Alumni Association always has going on, there were some specific projects he wanted to get accomplished.

One was a new and improved website for the group. The one we had was started in 2001 and needed updating. Our new website (same web address: www.westhighalumni.com) was introduced late last year. Especially after the onset of Covid, which resulted in all of the Alumni functions and resulting financial income we get from them being canceled, he also wanted to implement a fundraiser to help offset that deficit. In the fall of 2020 Dave introduced The Leadership Campaign with an initial goal of raising \$25,000. By the following March, the Leadership donations had already reached over \$31,000. We still receive donations with notes they are for the Leadership Campaign! The result of that Campaign has been very rewarding and will hopefully lead to several opportunities for the Alumni Association to expand our support for West High School and the great students who go there. Dave also volunteers at several Association activities including representing the Alumni Association at class reunions and helping at the football and basketball concessions.

Trying to get someone to fill the position of President is always challenging. This year was no different. When no one was willing to run for the next President, Dave offered to continue for 'one more year.' Then, just before the meeting when the 2022 officers were going to be elected, **Vida Fulton Williams '73** agreed to accept the position. When our Treasurer asked to be relieved of her duties in 2022 due to family and work obligations, Dave agreed to move to the Treasurer position. He will continue on the Board and be there to assist with his experience and guidance.

Dave has been generous with his office space, hosting the Board Meetings the last two-plus years. When we learned we could not hold the 2021 Hall of Fame Honoree Induction Ceremony in the West High Library, as had been the tradition in recent years, Dave offered his office again. As a 2008 Hall of Fame Honoree, Dave was aware of the importance the Alumni Board places on this annual program. Through his business he was able to set up the option of the Board Meetings using his Zoom account for Officers and Board Members who were uncomfortable attending meetings in person due to Covid.

We have appreciated all of our past presidents and their contributions to the efforts of our Association. The same is true with **Dave Dobos**. He has been the person we needed as our president for this time in our evolution. We know Dave will continue to stay involved as we continue to improve and grow the West Alumni Association.

We can't close without extending our sympathy to Dave on the passing of his mother, Helen Tozer Dobos Stone, who passed away on Christmas Eve at the age of 101. She led a long and very notable life. Our condolences to Dave and his extended family.

Thank you, Dave, for all you have done in the past and continue to do for the West Alumni Association.


Meet the Board

What year did you graduate from West?

What is your motivation for being involved with the Alumni Association?

1961 OSU Championship Football Team: The Real Story

A look back - From Dean Potts '59 Jan.

January 1959 West Alum David Francis was a standout athlete and student during his time at West. Dave was president of the January senior class and was voted 'Best All Around Athlete' his senior year. His football achievements were noticed by the legendary Football Coach Woody Hayes who recruited Dave to attend The Ohio State University. While at OSU, Dave was on the 1961 The Ohio State University Championship team. He played first string his sophomore, junior, and senior years.

Several from that 1961 team were in Columbus during the 2021 OSU Football Homecoming to celebrate the 60th anniversary of their Championship. As always happens when this group assembles, talk always goes back to how their season ended. Polly Francis, Dave's wife, shared an abbreviated version of that season.

The 1961 Team - Coach Woody Hayes - perfect season! Final Game: OSU 50, Michigan 20!

As an interesting twist, the Ohio State faculty did not really get along with Woody all that well. So, the faculty took the stance of "why bother going to the Rose Bowl?"

It will cost too much money, and we need to focus on academics.

After all was said and done, the press and sports associates agreed that OSU should go to the Rose Bowl. However, in the end, the faculty voted to rejet the invitation to the Rose Bobecause the school needed t concentrate on academics.

Pandemonium, protests, and capitol ensued. Minnesota v invited to the Rose Bowl in which they accepted.

Many years later, OSU admitted the mistake and Championship Rings were presented to all who were on the team. Dave still has his 1961 Championship Ring. He also has the famous 'Gold Pants' to show he was on teams that 'beat that team up north!'

A 1961, 60th Team Reunion happened on October 9, 2021, at the OSU Homecoming game. The group met the night before the game at Planks,

on Parsons Ave. They were introduced on the field at the Homecoming Game.


