Rachelle Coleman was awarded the Beverly Kimball Daugherty Memorial Scholarship. Mrs.

Daugherty was a 1963 graduate, and this scholarship is made possible by her husband, Mr. William Daugherty. 

April 20, 2023 was the date for this year's annual gathering for the West High School Alumni Association to return for a visit to their Alma Mater. Nearly 150 friends, family, classmates, faculty members and guests assembled in the cafeteria to meet and greet, reminisce about the old "Cowboy days," tour the building, and take a stroll down memory lane as they were treated to a westside tradition of Minelli's pizza.

The meeting began with an opening welcome by Dan Martin '72 at 6:05 p.m. Roll Call was

recorded by way of class decade sign in sheets. The class of the 70's was represented by the largest amounts of individuals in attendance, followed by classes of the 1980's, 1960's, 2010's 1950's and 2000's. Vida Fulton Williams '73 gratefully thanked those present that show overwhelming support and follow the alumni association by way of Facebook.

Mr. Martin thanked those in attendance for their membership and support of Alumni activities throughout the year. He introduced his administrative team, gave an update on the school and activities; then offered guided tours of the building.



General Meeting at Bella's Pizza Guest Speaker – Mr. Bob Zadrozny

For those of you who either had Mr. Bob Zadrozny as a teacher at West, or who remembered him when you were there, if you did not attend the February 22 meeting, you missed a great talk by our guest speaker for the evening. This very personable retired teacher, still referred to as "Mr. Z" by many, started by sharing how he happened to become a teacher at West. We might say it wasn't by chance – it was meant to be.

He had just graduated from The Ohio State University in 1968 and was looking for a teaching job. He said at that time the Columbus

Public School system was the best district in the area for teachers to be employed, so that was where he wanted to be. He went downtown to the CPS offices to schedule an appointment for an interview but was told the next possible interview time would be in the fall. He was determined to start teaching when school started in late August and did finally secure an interview for the following week. At the interview he was told there were two openings. One was at Crestview Junior High School and the other at West High School. Not familiar with either one, he decided to check out each school and do a 'drive-by.'

He first went to Crestview and thought it looked okay, a nice building. He then drove to the west side to West High. As he was getting close to the school, he could see this 'glow' in the sky and wondered what it was. As he drove down Powell Ave., he saw our historic cupola lighting up the sky. He was very impressed by the building and said to himself, "This is where I want to teach!" The next day Mr. Zadrozny

told his contact in Personnel, at the CPS offices, he wanted to teach at West. He was told to meet with West teacher, Mr. Richard Weber. He went to West, met with Mr. Weber, and was given a building tour. He was shown the room he would likely be teaching in if he took the job. It was next to the 'Radio Room.' He liked what he saw. After accepting the room assignment, Z was instructed that he would be responsible for the radio equipment and the morning announcements. When Mr. Weber asked if he could operate the radio controls, he confidently answered, "Oh, sure!" not knowing or having any training on the equipment. Fortunately for Z, the system had self-destructed (over the summer break) and did not work. A new radio system (with training included!) replaced the old and Z was safe to keep his room as he eagerly learned his way around the radio equipment and the morning announcements. All in all, he must have passed the "Weber" test as he was hired, placed in a room of his liking, on his first job, and he would be welcomed into teaching in a Columbus Public High School - West High School!

After getting the job he was very much looking forward to, the next important day was attending an 8am meeting at West with the other newly hired teachers. Having not had to get up early for anything for quite a while, he did not have an alarm to set to wake

him. And, as you can guess, he overslept! When he did wake up, he rushed to get to West, getting there after the 'new teacher' meeting had already begun. He tried to slip into the meeting, however, not being noticed was unavoidable. He was now 'the new guy who was late for his first teaching job.' As a mandatory 'all staff meeting' at West was scheduled for his second day of employment, he was driven to be there early, without delay. That plan didn't work out so well either. Living in the OSU campus area, the next day a delay occurred when a trash pickup vehicle was blocking his driveway. The meeting was being held in the Choir Room. When he got to the 3rd floor area, he saw a single door, past the Choir Room entrance, that went to the choir teacher's office. He decided to use that entrance and once again tried to slip into the room unnoticed.

Even if he weren't a tall person, all eyes would have still been on him when he came through the office door. Being tardy was unavoidable once again. So went his first two days as a West teacher!


Mr. Zadrozny treated us to a few fond memories, mannerisms, and individual stories about some of the 'more senior' teachers and administrators during his time at West - Mr. Heishman, Mr. Glass, Mr. Drury, Mr. Bower, Mr. Link, Mr. Kathary, Mr. Herman, and principals Mr. Randall and Mr. Abele. They were all special individuals that he looked up to and learned from. He enjoyed his time at West and the students he taught and coached. He refrained from naming many specific former students when telling some stories, except for two.

Steve Scarpitti '74 was at the meeting and confirmed (with a somewhat red face) the stories Mr. Zadrozny remembered and told about him when Z helped the drama, music, and theatre staff in the spring 1972 musical production of

Meredith Wilson's The Music Man. Steve knew he couldn't deny anything with his former teacher, who had a 'spot-on' memory, right there in front of him! Steve said, "Being in that production left an indelible mark on my heart and soul during my days at West."

Mr. Zadrozny also talked about his time coaching the 'In The Know' team to a 1st Runner-Up position in 1973 when Dave Dobos '73 was on the team. He mentioned that Dobos was a math whiz, and all pencils went down when such questions arose. Dave's correct answers were automatic points. West's winning streak was dashed as they lost winning it all to Columbus Academy in the final round.

Everyone enjoyed the close to an hour talk about West from a former teacher's perspective. He was very entertaining. We appreciate Mr. Zadrozny sharing his stories with us. Several alumni who have participated in our Alumni Golf Outing have been able to talk with him when there. He has participated in that event for several years. Mr. Zadrozny is truly a Friend of West High School, former staff, students, and especially the WHS Alumni Association. Kudos for his support, longevity, and dedication he has so generously and energetically devoted to West over the years.
