Musical Mike Wright '90

Sometimes the measure of a man is defined by the obstacle he overcomes.

Mike Wright, West High class of 1990, is such a man. Mike was born in 1972 with a rare eye disease called Retinitis Pigmentosa which is a disorder that rendered him legally blind. By the age of 7 years old, Mike's musical talent was discovered. He started with piano lessons that continued through college. Finding a music teacher in the 1970s that was willing to instruct a child with a disability was difficult as few understood the complexity of the disorder. Luckily for Mike, Don McDowell, a Westgate resident, was willing to take on that challenge. This is where Mike's passion for music began to develop.

Mike started to learn trumpet under the tutelage of Jim Esswein at Wedgewood Middle school. Later at West High School, Mike continued to develop his musical skills under the direction of Mark Sampson. Mark Sampson was instrumental in not allowing Mike's vision impairment to prevent him from being the best musician and best person he could be. At West, Mike was a member of the Marching Band, Jazz Ensemble, and Symphonic Band.

As a senior at West High, Mike auditioned and was selected for the Columbus Symphony Youth Orchestra. He had the distinction of being one of just a few students selected from the Columbus Public Schools as opposed to the students selected from the

private or suburban schools in the area. Along with all of the bands Mike played in through his time at West High, he also utilized his skills on piano to accompany vocal soloists for the annual variety show and he also contributed his musical talents to the

drama department.

Although Mike enjoyed being a performer, his real passion for teaching was discovered while tutoring music students at Wedgewood Middle. After graduating from West High, Mike attended Capital University earning his Bachelor of Music Education degree. While at Capital, Mike was fortunate to have many mentors, James Swearingen, Ray Eubanks, and Tim Swinehart to name a few.

In 1995, Mike graduated from Capital and married his wife, Diana. The two have raised two wonderful daughters, Alissa, and Bailey.

After graduating from Capital, Mike spent three years substitute teaching for Columbus City Schools. In 2000, thanks to West High graduate **Kim Hardy** '72, Mike was offered an opportunity to teach music for Ohio's first Online K-12 public school.

In 2005, Mike expanded his knowledge of utilizing technology in education by earning a Master's degree in Educational Technology. Although Mike has spent the past 22 years working for an online school, his passion for music still burns. Mike has taught privately for over 25 years and is still working with young musicians today.

In 2015, Mike formed a 22-piece big band named "Little Big Band of Columbus" which performs at retirement homes and festivals around the Columbus area. The band is comprised of amateur and professional musicians. Mike has said his goal for the band is "to give musicians an opportunity to perform and to simply have fun making music. The happiness the band brings to the various retirement homes around the city is immeasurable." Some of the musicians in the band include these West High graduates: Nancy Lloyd Laver '79, Brad Laver '75, Matt Hyland '90, John Frank '63 and Donovan McKinney '77.



College and Career Day at West


