The weather cooperated and offered a beautiful day for the Hilltop Bean Dinner on June 24th.



Focus on Alumni

Brent Bill, class of 1969 and member of the West High School Alumni Hall of Fame, will be releasing his 26th book this autumn. Titled "Amity: Stories from the Heartland," it is a collection of short stories, many of which are set in central Ohio, including on the Hilltop. Though it's fiction, many of the places mentioned will be familiar to West High folks and their friends.

These stories are about 1930s housewives, modern day priests, 1960s kids, and more --as well as the varieties and vagaries of their lives' trials, triumphs, failings, joys, sorrows, and surviving --and the beauty and mystery of it all.


One early reviewer said, "The people and places in these stories resonated with me in much the same way my own family stories resonate. It is as if Brent Bill has peered into our collective past and told the stories of our ancestors, people who are ours but who we have not yet met. And he imparts the stories with such grace and kindness, conveying that, "Here we are. This is what we are made of.

And it is good." I've not read stories like this since reading Wendell Berry." (Shawn Smucker, author of *Light from Distant Stars*)

Brent, whose parents (John Bill '47 and JoAnn Shields Bill '47) and sisters (Kathleen Bill Kramer '72 (Paul Kramer '73), Linda Bill '73, and Julie Bill Duff '75) are also West High graduates.

Brent's first published book came out in 1983. He's a popular speaker, retreat leader, and award-winning photographer in addition to being a writer. He's also a conservationist. He lives on almost 50 acres of Indiana farmland that has been turned into a wildlife preserve and now consists of native hardwood forest and tall grass prairie.

Your Alumni Association will accept any West yearbooks you want to donate. Through the generous donation of many alumni and families of alumni we have been able to build a collection of yearbooks for every West graduation year starting with 1912 – except 1913, 1917, and 1994.

Our Yearbook Library is a great resource for our newsletter editor to verity graduation years, find articles and pictures for the Alumni Newsletter, and look for information we often get questions about from alumni and alumni families.

These generous yearbook donations have resulted in us having multiple yearbooks for several graduation years. We receive yearbooks when an alum is downsizing a home, when two alums are married and have duplicate yearbooks, and when the family of a deceased alum donates yearbooks.

We offer the extra yearbooks to our alumni with a donation to our Alumni Scholarship Foundation! The donation request is \$25 for yearbooks from 1959 and prior and \$30 for yearbooks from 1960 and after.

To date we have had alumni make donations for over 400 yearbooks. That is almost \$12,000 of donations for our Alumni Scholarship Foundation!
