## 1975 AAA State Championship Baseball Team

On Monday, May 5th a reunion was held at West High School of the 1975 AAA State Championship Baseball Team. Many team members were present to relive the pride and glory of this amazing win. There were also many classmates, alumni, teachers, and coaches on hand to share in this 50th Anniversary celebration. Several team players and Head Coach Koblentz told stories about their win against Parma High School. This editor had a chance to hear these stories and also met team member Gregg Steger '75. Here are his responses to these questions:

#### Were you the captain of the team?

First of all, I was not team captain. Our team had no captains. Dave Koblentz' teams did not have team captains. Every member of our team was encouraged to step-up and demonstrate leadership. We also didn't award team Most Valuable Player (MVP) after the season ended. Our team belief was that every team member contributed

to the team's success. Everyone on our 1975 State Championship was recognized as Most Valuable Player.



Can you retell the story about the Parma High School championship game?

The State Championship game against Parma H.S. was the culmination of several previous seasons. Our team members had either played together or against each other since Little League. We knew each other and we knew that our team was talented. The entire Columbus City League had great baseball teams in the early 1970's. Besides West, schools such as Eastmoor, Whetstone, Northland, to name a few, also had tremendous talent. We competed very successfully against those programs and developed confidence to compete against anyone. Parma Senior H.S. had a very good team in 1975. Despite their overall record being under .500, we knew we'd

have to do our best to win the State Championship. And since we lost in the Regional Finals in 1974, we were very determined to take the State Championship back to West in 1975.

In the first few innings of the game against Parma, our hitting was unstoppable, and our pitching and defense shut down Parma's offense. Our lead was 23-4 heading into the 5th inning, at which time most of our starting lineup was replaced. Then, the momentum swung in favor of Parma. They scored 12 runs in the 5th inning and four more runs in the 6th inning. Our starting lineup re-entered the game in the 6th inning, scored a few more runs and then shut down Parma in the 7th inning for our State Championship victory. Final score: West 28 - Parma 20. The highest scoring State Championship baseball game in Ohio high school history. It's still the record. West H.S. center fielder Dean Smith set the individual record for most runs scored (6) in a State Championship game, and West H.S. first baseman Harold Williams set the individual record for most RBI's (8) in a State Championship game. Both of those are still Ohio High School Athletic Association records. And it remains the longest State Championship baseball game in Ohio history which lasted over 6 hours!

#### What life lessons did you learn from Coach David Koblentz?

Dave Koblentz taught his players lessons on the field which were ultimately life lessons:

Have "High Expectations." Always try to "Outwork Your Competition." Keep in mind that "Pressure is Privilege." Whatever you're



doing, "Prepare, Anticipate and React." Always be "Humble in Victory and Gracious in Defeat." Most importantly, Dave taught us the value of competing - not for ourselves or individual honors, but for each other.







reinforcing academic growth. This program is supported by West High School Alumni Association scholarship dollars that produced students from West to graduate from Columbus State before their West High School Graduation. Two students received this honor in 2024. This year, four students have the same honor. Congratulations!

West High remains the only 9–12 school in Columbus City Schools with a formal STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics) designation from the Ohio Department of Education & Workforce. This distinction prepares students for Ohio's growing STEM career market and aligns with CCS's evolving academies model. West was the only school, this size, in the state to receive this designation.

West will be transitioning to an Academy Model launching in 2025-2026. The design will consist of a career academy structure to personalize learning and deepen real-world readiness. Career paths will be patterned in the following format: Freshman Academy, Engineering/Manufacturing Academy, Marketing/Business Academy, and Public Health & Community Medicine Academy. These will provide students with themed learning communities, interdis-

ciplinary instruction, and real pathways to college and career success. Each center is supported by relevant academic coursework and industry-aligned skills development.

West High is actively seeking alumni and industry partners to support the academy model. Get involved by mentoring, offering job shadowing, contributing expertise, or joining an advisory committee. The West High School Alumni Association has been a staunch Community Supporter, presently through donations that assist the students with special projects, scholarships, team meals and special events. Additional volunteerism is welcomed.

In Closing, Dr. Roberts addressed those in attendance by stating: West High School Alumni Association Board, members, and guests, Thank You for Your Support! We're proud of where we've been improving as a school and even more excited about where we're going. Thank you for continuing to champion West High School. Let's keep growing leaders together!




